# 5. Maintenance Report:

Freehold drains – cleaning of some roadside drains on Peppermint Way was undertaken. Shire to employ contractor to clear the network of drains in the Freehold area from Williams Road through Peppermint Way to the Ring Road.

Leasehold drains -Noted drain at corner of East Ave and 1st Ave is blocked again

Beach Steps – repair on going.

Timber rails around the Bay require re-oiling. Committee to consider lodging a Project Nomination Form with the Walpole work camp – Check with Kelli on this.

Cigarette bins - Jeremy to supply plastic containers filled with sand.

Hall Maintenance – Katie and Greg to obtain quotes for painting interior and new kitchen cupboards. - ongoing.

Hall Storage Area – Committee noted the storage area is inadequate. Committee to obtain quote to rebuild storage area and Katie to submit quote to Gregg Harwood. (Ongoing – Katie).
