#### 4. Finance Report

Finance report presented by Katie Eddington, Treasurer.

PBPA was successful in receiving an additional \$5,000 towards the annual Maintenance Budget for the period to 30 June 2017 from the Shire of Denmark.

All proceeding to budget.

#### 5. Maintenance Report

Signs – boat launch area beach sign adjacent to swimming beach to be re-installed. Shire ranger contacted and site visit to be arranged when Ranger Charmain Shelly returns from annual leave - ongoing

Green Waste Pile 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Ave – Shire inspected the green waste pile and suggested that the pile remain as it is.

East Avenue Dust Suppressant and Drainage Modification – Shire Engineer informed – ongoing.

Drains – Shire inspected the drains on the corner of East and First Ave, and East and Fifth Ave. Drains running freely and no action required.

Alternative options for flexible posts and line marking of pedestrian/cycle path - ongoing.

Drain clearing in freehold and leasehold – Freehold drains completed by Shire Nov2016-Apr2017. Suggest freehold and leasehold drains are added to PBPA maintenance activities if increase in budget funds are received. Time estimate required is 80 hrs (10 days) per year.

Hall Storage Area – power board and lighting – ongoing.

Walkway and Railings at Swimming Beach – needs attention. Shire have inspected and noted works required. Submitted by PBPA as a municipal budget item – ongoing.

BBQ Oval – installation complete. Request funding for additional gazebo (to cover new BBQ) - Lotterywest or Shire Municipal Budget 2018/2019. Amber Ward to investigate Lotterywest grant.

Pole Saw – requires parts to fix.

Quad Bike - requires annual service before summer.

#### 6. General Business

Sewerage Infrastructure – seek feedback from Shire as to if there are any current plans? Eg Munglinup, Ravensthorpe and Hyden - Septic Tank Effluent Disposal (STED) scheme. The PBPA recognises that sewerage infrastructure would be an asset to the Peaceful Bay and broader Denmark Community and Shire. The PBPA suggests that a Shire of Denmark reserve fund is established to fund this asset with annual contributions from rates and rent revenue.

Historical Pictorial of Peaceful Bay - ongoing

Historical Signs – possible cultural grant April 2018? Consider reinstalling old signs near the playground. Mavis reports old signs can be re-installed along fence adjacent to new playground.

Recycling - Shire currently reviewing all recycling matters for region. Ongoing

Entry Statement – The Shire of Denmark is currently undertaking a Review of the Strategic Community Plan. Entry statements for Peaceful Bay, Nornalup, Bow Bridge and Denmark are being considered.

Speed Reduction Rame Head Road – Shire informed and awaiting feedback from Shire Engineer

Speed Reduction Tip Intersection – Speed zone has been reduced to 60kmh. Now 60km/hr zone along Peaceful Bay Road from Ficifolia Road.

Wheelie Bin Collection – feedback provided to Shire to stay as is. Awaiting formal feedback from Shire.

Budget Items 2017/2018 FY - submitted

- 1. Increase funding for Maintenance (request \$40,000)
- 2. Beach Parking enlarge
- 3. Maintenance of wooden pathway and stairs to swimmers beach
- 4. Hall Kitchen Area renovation and modification

#### 7. Other Business

PBPA to request that the Shire investigate construction of turning lanes for South Coast Highway/Peaceful Bay Road intersection.

Review of the Strategic Community Plan – Denmark 2027 – Stage 3 to be advertised shortly.

Shire PBPA Bins A5616 - PBPA to inform SoD Shire Engineer Gilbert Arlandoo that the Association Hall does not have a bin assigned.
