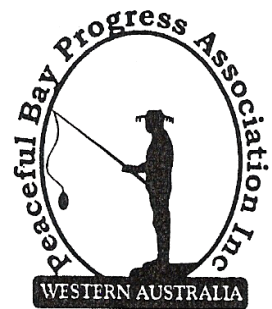

PRESIDENTS REPORT

Greetings All,

During the past 12 months the Peaceful Bay Progress Association has been working to conserve and maintain the village of Peaceful Bay, the atmosphere and the history that makes the Bay what it is. This would not happen without the hard-work of the committee and volunteers and our maintenance man, Jeremy Newman. Thank you to all- we couldn't do it without you.

We would like to acknowledge the support we have received from Councillors Janine Phillips and Roger Seeney, as representatives for the Kent/Nornalup Ward. Councillor Phillips has represented the Progress Association on numerous occasions at council and has kept us well informed at all times.

After lobbying for some time Janine is happy to report that we have finally had some success and the Shire of Denmark has allocated a significant sum of money for the Peaceful Bay Reserve fund. The Shire has also commenced work cleaning out the lagoon that supplies our town water.

This year saw a change in the rubbish collections to include a seasonal pick-up. The Progress Association have had the dates amended to include Easter and we thank the Shire of Denmark for being considerate of our unique needs in the Bay.

The garden at the entry to Fifth Avenue was completed and another project has been planned for next year. This will involve the area around the car park, community notice board and telephone box and will greatly improve the look of the village.

2018 has also seen the Progress Association set up a Facebook page for residents and ratepayers of Peaceful Bay. The group is a 'closed group' so only those who live or have holiday homes here can become members. It is very simple to become a member, just go to our page and click on 'join group'. Thanks to Hayden Jones, Kristy Bailey and Jo Brady for setting this up and keeping it up to date.

A Bushfire Ready group has been set up in recent months and in the wake of the fires earlier in the year, it was a very timely exercise. Co-ordinators have been established in each area of the bay, including the freehold and outlying farms. These people will make themselves known to you and will updating contact details, so they can get in touch with you in the event of a bushfire. A flyer has recently been printed and will be delivered to each residence over the next couple of weeks. Please keep your eye out for this as it contains some very important messages.

Once again the Christmas Party will be happening on 22 December at the Progress Association Hall with a barbecue and Father Christmas in attendance to hand out presents to the children. Please come along and join in the fun.

The Family Fun Day will be held on New Year's Day, with all the usual fun events for kids and big kids alike. A sausage sizzle and cool drinks will be available so bring a hat, bring your whole family and enjoy the day!

Bushfire Ready Group - In response to the bushfire that threatened Peaceful Bay and impacted Nutkin Lodge on May 24th the community now has a bushfire ready group. The aim is to create a contact list so that information can be shared quickly in the event of a fire or other emergency. Street co-ordinators have been appointed and will be visiting residents over the summer period to make you aware of the Peaceful Bay Bushfire Ready Plan and to get the best contact person and phone number for your house. The flyer enclosed should be kept at your place at Peaceful Bay as it contains the contact numbers of your street co-ordinator, so please, if they miss you it is important that you contact them with your details.

When asking to join please be aware that there are a couple of questions regarding your connection to Peaceful Bay as this is a closed group and all posts are monitored by a committee member as coordinator. We want to keep the page relevant and tidy ! The Facebook page will operate in conjunction with the PBPA website so newsletters, meeting minutes, events calendar and community information will continue to be updated.

The AGM needs community support, so we look forward to members coming along and also considering if they would like to serve on the committee in 2019. The meeting will take place at the Hall on First Ave on Saturday 5th January at 7.30 pm.

Security Over the Holiday Period

A similar service as previous years will be in place to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable celebrations over the festive season. Patrols will take place and will monitor anti-social behaviour, street drinking and underage alcohol consumption. Parents and guardians are encouraged to take responsibility for all young people at their hut.

4WD Around Peaceful Bay - Please consider the environment when using your 4WD vehicle at the Bay. Also inform everyone who may use your hut that if we don't look after the tracks they will in all probability be closed down to protect the coastline, monitoring is already in place. Reducing tyre pressure is a sound practice to make your experience hassle free - 16 PSI is a good tyre pressure to start with as it takes the pressure off the tracks AND your vehicle. Also please take your rubbish back with you. Don't leave it in the bush or on the beach !

Dogs - Please be aware that Peaceful Bay is the same as your home town and If your dogs are kept in your yard at home the same should apply when you come to the Bay. Dogs should be kept on a leash unless they are in a designated dog exercise area. Although the Inlet beach does allow dogs off leash it would be appreciated if owners kept their animals under control for their safety and the enjoyment of other beach users. Domestic animals are not allowed in National Parks and a \$200 fine exists for each dog caught in the National Park. Could be an expensive day out !

Number Plates - The Progress Association has number plates for sale at a price of \$300. The attractive plates remain a popular item and there are still many lower numbers to choose from. Please contact Katie Eddington if you would like to purchase a plate - 9840 8088.

Newsletters – The PBPA strives to keep you informed with news from around the Bay. The PBPA will post or email one newsletter per year to all residents of the Bay.

Peaceful Bay Sea Rescue – The Shire of Denmark has imposed a 20 metre NO PARKING zone either side of the finger jetty so that boat owners can safely launch and retrieve their boats. No radio operators are currently based in Peaceful Bay. The Sea Rescue Group has eight people willing to undertake a course to man the Peaceful Bay radio, hopefully an Instructor can be found to run the course before Christmas. Meanwhile, the Denmark Sea Rescue is covering the Peaceful Bay sea rescue log ins and their call channel is 613. The Peaceful Bay call sign is 616.

Community Interest Item:

INFORMATION ON FEDERATION CENTENARY PLAQUES (2001) REMOVED FROM ORIGINAL PLAYGROUND FENCING. (circa 2015)

The plaques were a project undertaken by the young women of Peaceful Bay during the national celebration of the Centenary of Federation in 2001 with funding coming from a Federal Grant. The youngsters of the Bay and their families were able to enjoy this brief history lesson. The information contained on these plaques has been recorded here in the hope a similar project will be undertaken in the future.

- Plaque No.1 1622-1791 – The Dutch ship Leeuwin examined the South Coast
between Cape Leeuwin & Esperance.
1699 – William Dampier landed on the North Western Australia Coast.
- Plaque No.2 1770 – Captain Cook Discovered the East Coast of Australia.
1791 – “King George Sound” (Albany) named.
- Plaque No.3 1801 –Matthew Flinders completed charting “New Holland” (Australia).
1817 – “New Holland” Renamed “Australia”
- Plaque No.4 1829 – Captain James Stirling founded the “Swan River Settlement”
(Fremantle & Perth).
Mt. Frankland named.
Denmark area first explored.
- Plaque No.5 1850-1868 – 9,668 convicts were transported to Western Australia.
Circa 1895 – Denmark Founded.
- Plaque No.6 1901 – Federation of Australia
- Plaque No.7 1908 – Bow Bridge Pioneered.
1910 – Nornalup Pioneered.
- Plaque No.8 1914-1918 – World War 1
1914 – November 1st the first convoy of Australian soldiers sail from
Albany.
- Plaque No.9 1922 – Group Settlement 116 Tingle Dale.
1924 – Peaceful Bay named prior to this time. The exact date is
unknown.
1927 – Group Settlement 138 & 139 Hazelvale.
- Plaque No.10 1929 – Railway line to Nornalup Opened.
1935 – Peaceful Bay Road surveyed.
1938 – February 10th. The Great Fire.
- Plaque No.11 1939-1945 – World War II.
1948 – 1st Salmon Camp at Peaceful Bay.
1950-1953 – Korean War.
- Plaque No.12 1957 – “Elleker-Nornalup” Railway line closed.
- Plaque No.13 1970–1980 - This is the decade which saw the end of the cattle
roaming area, milk delivery & the night cart man.
- Plaque No.14 1972 – Electricity supplied to Peaceful Bay.
1974 – Quarram cattle lease ended.
- Plaque No.15 1975 – End of Vietnam
“Koshin Maru” Japanese Tuna Boat grounded at Foul Bay.
- Plaque No.16 1989 – Doctor’s Surgery, hall, fire brigade building completed.
- Plaque No.17 1991 – Jack Battye’s boat sank in the Bay.
1995 – Centennial oval opened. (Peaceful Bay)
- Plaque No.18 1999 – Peaceful Bay basket ball court completed.
2000 – Flag Hill 2nd Restoration.
Peaceful Bay Sea Rescue building opened.

FAMILY FUN DAY

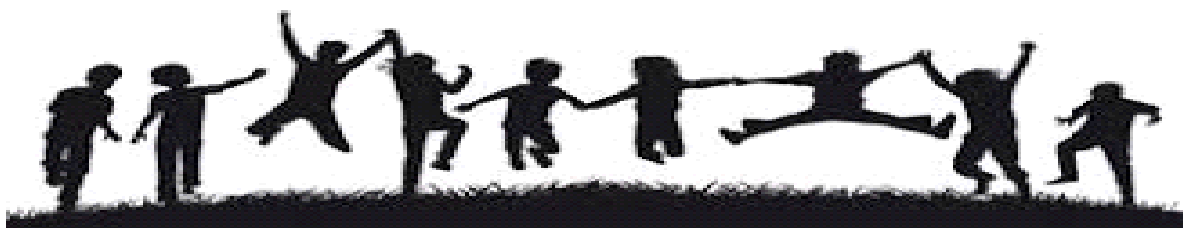
